Title: Choreographer & Technician - Winterguard

Primary Purpose

The Choreographer & Technician supports the winterguard ensemble in developing the fundamental flag, weapon, and dance skillsets among students to successfully execute an indoor show. This role requires flexibility for both in-person and remote work, with occasional travel.

Choreographer (40%)

Key responsibilities:

- Work alongside the Program Director in the development and implementation of choreography with and without equipment.
- Assist the Program Director in teaching assigned choreography under guidance of the Program Director.
- Assist the Program Director in development of warm up sequences to develop necessary skillsets.

Technician (60%)

Key responsibilities:

- Work alongside the Program Director in the implementation of the show design.
- Lead performers in regular rehearsal activities, providing oversight, leadership, and direction of performers under guidance of the Program Director.
- Work closely with performers in reinforcing and correcting proper technique.
- Assist the Program Director in re-writes of warm up sequences and show design.
- Assist in the organization and execution of ensemble performances at competitions and events.
- Attendance at competitions and performances is required.
- Other duties as assigned.

A high school diploma, GED or equivalent, and three (3) years of experience as a performer or instructor; or a combination of education and experience to successfully execute the key responsibilities of the position. Individual must have and maintain a non-expired Level
